

Key Areas of Learning

As **historians**, we will be considering the impact of the fall of the Roman Empire on British history. We will be looking at what happened when Britain was invaded by a range of different peoples and finding evidence which is still around today. We will look at a range of evidence and then become historians ourselves seeing what we can discover from the archaeological artefacts discovered at Sutton Hoo. As **scientists**, we will be building on our knowledge and understanding of different systems within the body. We will research the parts and functions of the circulatory system and look at the transportation of nutrients around the human body. We will be exploring how a healthy lifestyle supports the body to function.

English

We are continuing to read Holes by Louis Sachar in our reading lessons, which we will be working on together as a class.

When becoming writers, we will be writing time-slip stories, focussing on setting descriptions and seeing a setting through a character's eyes.

Maths
