Key Areas of Learning

As **historians**, we will be researching the history of England from the end of the Roman era up until the reign of Edward the Confessor. Maths

This term the focus is on Number.

Children will also develop their times table knowledge and recall through Times Tables Rock Stars.

German

Computing
