We would like to remind all parents that as a healthy school, snacks should all be a piece of fruit or vegetable.



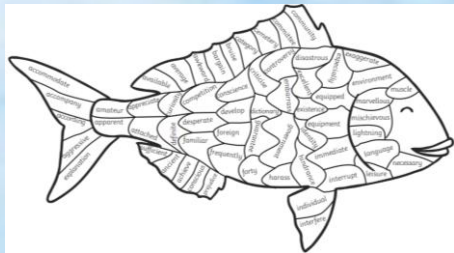

- Spelling fish – statutory word lists (tested September, February and June)



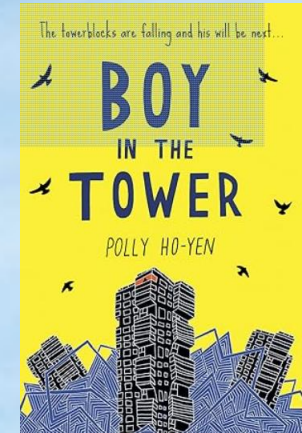


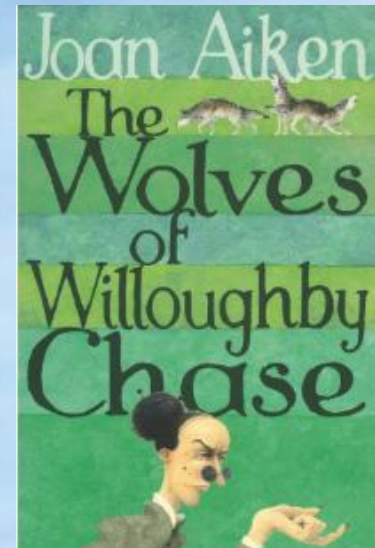
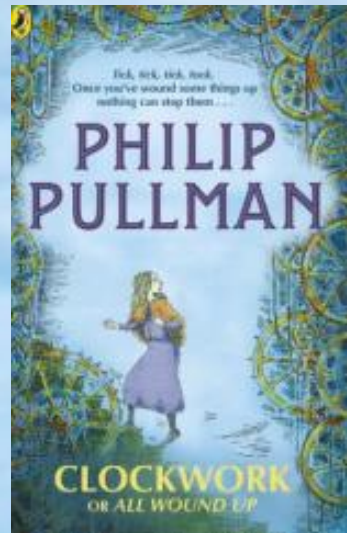
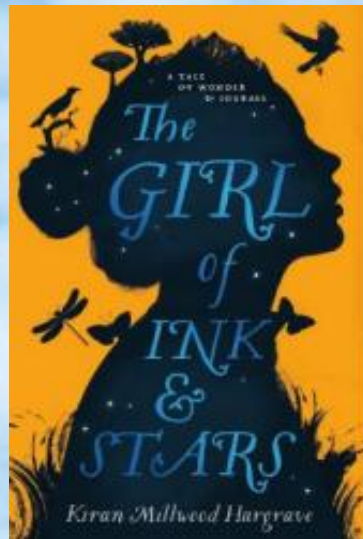
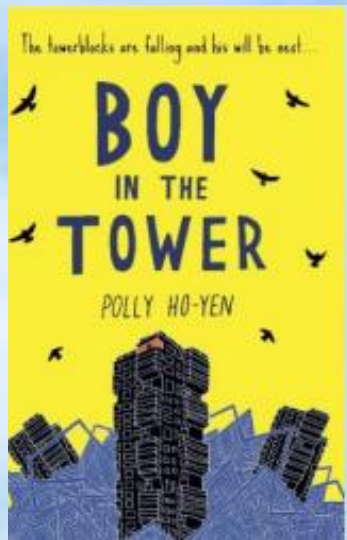
Reading
